**IMPORTANT-READ CAREFULLY:** This End User Licence Agreement ("EULA") is a legal agreement between YOU as Licensee and Systemic Pty Ltd for the SOFTWARE PRODUCT identified above. By installing, copying, or otherwise using the SOFTWARE PRODUCT, YOU agree to be bound by the terms of this EULA. If YOU do not agree to the terms of this EULA, promptly delete the SOFTWARE PRODUCT from your system(s). The copyright in the SOFTWARE PRODUCT and its documentation is owned by Systemic Pty Ltd. Subject to the terms of this EULA, YOU are granted a non-exclusive right for the duration of the EULA to use the SOFTWARE PRODUCT. YOU do not acquire ownership of copyright or other intellectual property rights in any part of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT by virtue of this EULA.

Your use of this software indicates your acceptance of this EULA and warranty.

### **DEFINITIONS**

In this End User Licence Agreement, unless the contrary intention appears,

"EULA" means this End User Licence Agreement

"Systemic " means Systemic Pty Ltd.

"Licensee" means YOU, or the organisation (if any) on whose behalf YOU are taking the EULA.

"Registered Edition of Voltaic" means the edition of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT which is available for purchase from the web site: <http://shedworx.com>.

"SOFTWARE PRODUCT" or "SOFTWARE" means the VoltaicHD Converter which includes computer software and associated media and printed materials, and may include online or electronic documentation.

"Support Services" means email based support provided by Systemic, including advice on usage of Voltaic, investigation of bugs, fixes, repairs of models if and when appropriate and general product support.

"Trial edition of Voltaic" means the edition of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT which is available free of charge for evaluation purposes for 15 video conversions.

### **GRANT OF LICENCE**

In accordance with the terms of this EULA YOU are granted the following rights:

a) to install and use one copy of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT, or in its place, any prior version for the same operating system, on a single

computer.

b) to store or install a copy of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT on a storage device, such as a network server, used only to install or run the SOFTWARE PRODUCT over an internal network. If YOU wish to increase the number of users entitled to access the SOFTWARE PRODUCT, YOU must notify Systemic and agree to pay an additional fee.

c) to make copies of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT for backup and archival purposes.

### **EVALUATION LICENCE**

The Trial version of Voltaic is not free software. Subject to the terms of this agreement, YOU are hereby licenced to use this software for evaluation purposes without charge for 10 video conversions, for file sizes up to 25Mb.

The Trial version of VoltaicHD is provided to the potential customer so that the customer can ensure the product works on their combination of camera and computer (both hardware and software). If the software does not work as advertised, the customer must contact ShedWorx support (voltaicmac@shedworx.com) in order to resolve any problems before a refund will be considered. Refunds will not be given to customers after 30 days.

Upon expiration of the evaluation period, the SOFTWARE PRODUCT must be removed from the computer. Unregistered use of Voltaic after the 10 usage evaluation period is in violation of Australian, U.S. and international copyright laws.

If YOU choose to use this software after the evaluation period a licence must be purchased (as described at <http://shedworx.com>). Upon payment of the licence fee, YOU will be sent a software licence 'key' by email.

### **ADDITIONAL RIGHTS AND LIMITATIONS.**

YOU hereby undertake not to sell, rent, lease, translate, create derivative works of, modify, sub-licence, loan, distribute, adapt, vary, decompile, disassemble or reverse engineer the SOFTWARE PRODUCT other than as expressly authorised by this EULA.

YOU are permitted to modify the SOFTWARE PRODUCT for your own use and to reverse engineer the SOFTWARE for the purpose of debugging such modifications.

YOU further undertake not to reproduce or distribute activation keys except under the express and written permission of Systemic.

### **ASSIGNMENT**

YOU may only assign all your rights and obligations under this EULA to another party if YOU supply to the transferee a copy of this EULA and all

other documentation including proof of ownership. Your licence is then terminated.

### **TERMINATION**

Without prejudice to any other rights, Systemic may terminate this EULA if YOU fail to comply with the terms and conditions. Upon termination YOU or YOUR representative shall destroy all copies of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT and all of its component parts or otherwise return or dispose of such material in the manner directed by Systemic.

### **WARRANTIES AND LIABILITY**

#### **WARRANTIES**

Systemic warrants that the SOFTWARE PRODUCT will perform substantially in accordance with the accompanying written materials for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of receipt, and any Support Services provided by Systemic shall be substantially as described in applicable written materials provided to YOU by Systemic, and Systemic support engineers will make commercially reasonable efforts to solve any problems associated with the SOFTWARE PRODUCT.

#### **EXCLUSIONS**

To the maximum extent permitted by law, Systemic excludes, for itself and for any supplier of software incorporated in the SOFTWARE PRODUCT, all liability for all claims, expenses, losses, damages and costs made against or incurred or suffered by YOU directly or indirectly (including without limitation lost costs, profits and data) arising out of:

However, the liability of Systemic for any breach of such term shall if permitted by legislation be limited, at Systemic's option to any one or more of the following upon return of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT and a copy of the receipt.

- the replacement of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT or the supply of an equivalent SOFTWARE PRODUCT; or
- the repair of such SOFTWARE PRODUCT; or
